Description

Certification

Subject to assessment, all participants will be issued with an **Bloodborne and Airborne Pathogen** certificate from either the American Safety & Health Institute (ASHI) or Emergency Safety & Care Institute (ECSI) depending on the course taken.

This qualification is valid for 2 years which can be renewed by attending re-qualification course.
